Each shooter has the opportunity to place in competitions individually or as a team depending on their final scores/team total score. Dues

Practices

Tentative schedule will consist of two-hour practices, held on Mondays. Based on shooting locations, we will begin practice at 6:00pm and end at 8:00pm. Shooting location is currently at the JROTC range at Hiram High School on Ballentine Rd.

The season goes from November- early May and then May- July for the Nationals qualifying shooters only.

Registration

- Enrollment is open to 4th- 9th graders
- New shooter participation is limited depending on the number of coaches. Additional space may be added depending on the number of returning shooters.
- Sign up will begin Nov 7th and end Nov 9th on a first come first served basis.

- Team fees will be due by Friday November 17th
- Each shooter will need a Daisy 499 rifle it is the parents responsibility to purchase. Please call Daisy Outdoors to order the 499 rifle (800) 643-3458 (cost will be around \$120 after shipping)
- Each shooter and certified coach will receive a team shirt. Extra shirts/ hoodies will be available to be ordered at an extra cost.

General Information

- Parents will complete enrollment and medical forms to be turned in with registration. Once registered, a Code of Conduct (expected 4-H behavior) agreement will be sent via email
- Gun assembly will be provided to new shooters at practice.
- This is NOT a drop off club. Each shooter needs at least one parent/ guardian to stay with them at each practice and competition.
- Parents are encouraged to become screened volunteers with The University of Georgia. This screening process allows parents to chaperone events or help other students at practices.
