Example - Three facts about ice cream: history of ice cream, how to make ice cream, and different types of ice cream. Write 3-4 sentences <u>per fact</u>.</p> <p>C. Conclusion: Restate the topic and thank the audience for listening. 2-3 sentences</p> <p><i>Write your speech on note cards and have them on presentation day!</i></p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Step 2 Pick one topic and begin your research using CREDIBLE sources.</p>	<p> A special invitation to the county-wide contest will be given to those who present!</p>
