Rules and Regulations

- Exhibitor's Handbooks are distributed ONE copy per family.
- This division assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damages from any cause to stock or other exhibits; and on this condition only, are entries received.
- Late entries WILL NOT be accepted. There will be NO exceptions. Please don't ask!
- All exhibits must have been made during the current 4-H program year.
- In classes where age of a member is a requirement, the age will be considered as January 1 of the current year.
- Each exhibit must have an exhibitor's entry tag attached to it. To attach the entry tag to the exhibit: use pins, tape, or punch a hole in one corner of the entry tag and use string to tie it on.
- Extension Fest will officially open on Tuesday, July 23 at 3:00 pm.

A Philosophy of Judging

Have you developed your own philosophy of judging? Do you know why your work is judged? Do you know who are asked to be judges? Do you accept the awards you get gracefully whether it be blue, red, or white? If your answer is "yes" to all of these questions, you need to read no further. But many 4-H members and others do not know all the answers.

Why Do We Judge?

The two major purposes in judging are: 1). To determine the worth of a piece of work. How well it was done and how closely does it conform to the standards of quality. 2). To contribute to the growth and development of 4-H members and others concerned with positive youth development allowing 4-H members to learn through hands on opportunities. .

Who Are The Judges?

Judges are people! They are asked to be judges because they have special training and background in certain subject matter areas. Not all judges have the same training and same background in the same subject matter area and that is why judges sometimes differ in their opinions and ideas as to how something should be done. The process of judging will never be perfect. Judges can evaluate only what they see. They can't know how hard one member has worked or what obstacles another may have had to overcome. So, they must judge just what they see according to a standard. They can guess a little about what to expect from members of a certain age, or years of experience in demonstrating, but even here there is a difference of opinion.

We have to learn to accept judging for the best it can do for us and reconcile ourselves to some of the faults that are impossible to overcome. Learn what you can from an evaluation, but don't take it personally or too seriously - don't make it the ultimate decision of your worth. Consider judging an adventure to stimulate you to greater achievement.

The Danish System

The Danish System of judging is used at many 4-H events. Each item is judged according to a standard (set of criteria) rather than against each other. 4-H leaders, members and parents should be informed about the criteria before members exhibit projects or enter competitions. There is no limit to the number of entries that receive each level of award (blue, red or white).

Blue or Excellent - The workmanship shows little need for improvement compared to the relative standard.

Red or Good - The workmanship is satisfactory or average but there are definite areas for improvement, even considering the age and challenges of the child.

White or Worthy - The workmanship shows that a worthy effort has been made and that the finished product is useable for the purpose intended. However, there is much need for improvement even considering the age and challenges of the child.

Judging will occur ONLY on items properly labeled according to the following requirements: Name, Grade, School, Teacher, item number in which to be judged AND item description

All items will be judged by the Danish System of judging: Judged on the quality of work you have put into making it and not compared to other entries.

Canning items: standard canning jars required; properly sealed lids; clean (not sticky) exterior. Others will be disqualified.


4-H member can enter only one item for each number listed.

Items will be properly displayed, judged, and cared for; further than this, responsibility ceases.


All items must be made by 4-H'er. Photos entered MUST have been TAKEN BY THE 4-H'ER.

BEHAVIOR STANDARDS

The Georgia 4-H Code of Conduct is valid for one year and applies to all activities coordinated through Georgia 4-H.

- 4-H'ers are expected to attend all sessions as part of a planned program exhibiting positive character and behavior including (but not limited to) trustworthiness, responsibility, respectfulness, caring, citizenship and fairness.
- 4-H'ers are expected to be responsive to the reasonable requests of leaders and respectful of the needs for their personal safety and the safety of others.
- 4-H'ers should dress appropriately, use appropriate language and respect the rights of others.
- 4-H'ers may not behave recklessly or in a manner which prohibits others from participating in the program in the manner intended.
- 4-H'ers may have access to technology at UGA/CES offices and facilities. Technology use is for educational purposes. 4-H'ers may not access inappropriate websites or materials.
- Realizing these guidelines are not "all inclusive" the University of Georgia Extension staff and volunteers reserve the right to make adjustments to these policies.

CONSEQUENCES OF MISBEHAVIOR

4-H'ers and adults who observe a breach in the Code of Conduct must report the misbehavior to the appropriate leader. The leader will complete an incident report and determine the next steps regarding the incident.

If 4-H'ers are found participating in actions listed below, during 4-H events, law enforcement or other legal authorities may be notified and may lead the review and consequences related to the incident. In these incidents, 4-H'ers may be removed from the event and suspended or expelled from future 4-H participation. These behaviors may include, but are not restricted to:

- Possession or use of illegal drugs
- Possession or use of a weapon
- Assault or harassment
- Inappropriate sexual behavior

4-H'ers who participate in these actions outside of the program may also be removed, suspended, or expelled from future 4-H participation.

If the 4-H'er is found participating in the actions listed below, 4-H leaders may be notified and may lead the review and consequences related to the behavior. 4-H'ers misbehaving will have the opportunity to explain their actions to leaders in charge of the activity and may request a review board. The person coordinating the event may also convene a review board for the purposes of determining what has occurred and what disciplinary action should be taken. A review board will consist of one Extension faculty or staff member, two volunteers and three 4-H members. The Extension faculty member coordinating the event will serve as chairperson. In some cases, incidents are deemed serious and may be referred to law enforcement or other legal authorities.

If the 4-H'er receives consequences from the leader or through the review process, his/her parents/guardians may be notified; the 4-H'er may be sent home at the parents' expense and may be suspended from participation in 4-H events. Suspensions may be up to one year. If a 4-H'er wishes to appeal the decision of the review board, the 4-H'er must appeal in writing through the County Extension office. Appeals must be filed within 10 days of notification of the disciplinary action. The appeal is sent to the Program Development Coordinator of the 4-H member and the State 4-H Leader for ruling by the State 4-H Leader. Following any disciplinary review, the person coordinating the activity will provide written notification to the appropriate parties including but not limited to the 4-H'er, his/her parent/guardian and his/her county Extension faculty member.

- Breaking curfew or disturbing the peace
- Unexcused absences from the activities or premise of an event
- Unauthorized use of vehicles during the event
- Reckless or inappropriate behavior
- Use of foul or offensive language
- Possession or use of alcohol or tobacco
- Possession or use of e-cigarettes or other vaping devices
- Breach of the 4-H Code of Ethics
- Remaining in the presence of those who are breaking the 4-H Code of Conduct
- Theft, misuse or abuse of public or personal property
- Possession of fireworks
- Distribution, misuse, or abuse of over-the-counter, homeopathic, including supplements and vitamins, or prescription medications
