4-H Summer Events

Forestry judging: Forestry judging is one of our traditional summer activities at the 4-H office. We hold study sessions throughout the summer for students to prepare for the September area competition. One component of the competition is tree identification from leaf samples. We will learn about leaf anatomy, identifying traits, and unusual fruits or thorns that will help to correctly identify the species. Another component of the competition is identifying insects and diseases which are harmful to the forest. The contest will also include estimating distance by counting paces, using a compass (for students in grades 9-12), and estimating volume of timber harvest for a designated forest stand using 5 marked trees. While we cannot announce study dates at this time, we will begin them as soon as we can. You may visit our website (listed above), click on the “judging teams” tab, and under the forestry judging heading you will find quite a few of our study resources so you can begin to study on your own until we schedule workshops.

Dairy Month Poster Contest

June is National Dairy Month and The Dairy Alliance invites Georgia 4-H'ers to design a poster that informs people of the health benefits of milk. The purpose of the poster is to convince people to consume more dairy products. The theme for this year's contest is **"The Art of Dairy"**. Prizes that will be awarded by the Dairy Association are: first prize—\$100, second prize—\$75 and third prize—\$50. To enter follow the rules listed below and **submit a photograph of your poster and a photograph of the entry form to the following email address: clarke4hphotocontest@gmail.com. Please put "dairy poster contest" in the subject line and send by May 15.**



Poster contest rules:

- The poster must be original, hand-drawn artwork done by the participant. Computer generated artwork and text are not acceptable and will result in disqualification of the poster.
- Poster must be on standard poster board and exactly 14 x 22 inches (half a poster board), other sizes are automatically disqualified and are not submitted for judging or eligible for prizes
- Use the slogan **"The Art of Dairy"** as the theme. Stick to the theme, keep it simple and to the point
- Posters must be flat. Do not attach items to your poster.
- You **may not** include newspaper, film cartoon characters or other copyrighted characters or symbols
- You may get ideas from television, magazines, parents, and friends. You may also study pictures at the grocery store, web sites of the Dairy Alliance or the National Dairy Council.
- The judges guidelines for scoring are: originality that attracts attention, following theme, conveying the message of the health benefits of milk, general appearance (well planned, easy to read, neat, no spelling errors) and accurate information
- To be eligible for a prize you must complete and attach the official entry form (page 4 of this newsletter) to the back of your poster.
