<u>County Competition is Virtual this year: Videos due March 1</u> **District Competition is also Virtual**

County Project Achievement is a fun opportunity for 5^{th} & 6^{th} grade 4-H'ers to share and compete with one another by choosing a project and presenting a demonstration with visuals. Due to safety restrictions, the County level competition will not be held in person this year. However, students can still compete by sending video of them presenting their demonstration. Any 5^{th} or 6^{th} grade 4-H'er who wishes to compete in this activity will need to send their video to Ms. Conway by **March 1** at ebarber@uga.edu.

Farm Bureau Essay Contest for Middle School Students Essay & Entry Form due to Clarke County Farm Bureau Office February 26

The Clarke County Farm Bureau sponsors an annual essay contest for students currently in 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. There will be county, district and state prizes awarded for winning essays.

The topic for this year's essay contest is "How does utilization of Certified Farm Markets and agritourism benefit both the farmer and the consumer?"

Agritourism is a sector of Georgia Agriculture that provides an on the farm experience to help develop a unique connection between a producer and a consumer. Contest guidelines: Essays should be typed, double spaced and no more than two pages or three pages handwritten on lined notebook paper. Do not put your name on your essay. Include the completed entry form containing your contact information and parent signature with your essay. Be sure to cite any references that you use in preparing your essay. Submit your entry by mail or deliver your essay as listed below.
