Dairy Month Poster Contest



June is National Dairy Month and The Dairy Alliance invites Georgia 4-H'ers to design a poster that informs people of the health benefits of milk. The purpose of the poster is to convince people to consumer more dairy products. The theme for this years contest is **"May the Dairy be with You!"** Prizes that will be awarded by the Dairy Association are first Prize \$100, second prize \$75, and third prize \$50.

To enter follow the rules listed below and submit your poster to the 4-H office by May 1, 2024.

Poster Contest Rules:

- The Poster must be original, hand-drawn artwork done by the participant. Computer generated artwork and text are not acceptable and will result in disqualification of the poster.
- Poster must be standard poster board and exactly 14x22 inches (half a poster board), other sizes are automatically disqualified and are not submitted for judging or eligible for prizes.
- Use the slogan " May the Dairy be with You" as the theme. Stick to the theme. Keep it simple and too the point.
- Posters must be flat. Do not attach items to your poster.
- You may not include newspaper, film or cartoon characters, or other copyrighted characters or symbols.
- You may get ideas from television, magazines, parents, and friends. You may also study pictures at the grocery store, websites of the Dairy Alliance or the National Dairy Council.
- The judges guidelines for scoring are: originality that attracts attention, following theme, conveying the message of the health benefits of milk, general appearance (well planned, easy to read, neat, no spelling errors) and accurate information.
- To be eligible for a prize you must submit the following information with your poster: FIRST & LAST NAME OF 4-H MEMBER, STREET ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, & POSTAL CODE.
