Design a holiday card for our 4-H holiday card contest! The winning design will be featured on our Athens-Clarke County 4-H holiday card. This card will be sent to the mayor, school board, county commissioners, and other local dignitaries.

- 1. Make your drawing on white unlined 8.5 by 5.5-inch paper. This is one half of regular computer printer paper. The size is very important.
- 2. Put your NAME, ADDRESS, GRADE, AND SCHOOL on the back of the card.
- 3. Include the 4-H symbol, the 4-leaf clover, in your design.
- 4. Submit your card to your teacher before your October club meeting. This is an excellent way to earn points for club of the month!

Here are a few helpful hints to make your holiday card:

Use a universal December holiday theme such as "Happy Holidays" or "Seasons Greetings" rather than focusing on Christmas, Hannukah, or another winter holiday. We want everyone to enjoy the card no matter what holiday they celebrate.

Consumer Judging is an afterschool activity to prepare for the district competition held in **Watkinsville on Thursday November 9**. In consumer judging students will read details that a person needs when shopping for a particular product. Students will then compare four products in the category and evaluate how each satisfies the stated requirements. The categories for this year's competition are Bluetooth speakers, Athletic socks, Family games, and Cereal.

Workshops will be held at the 4-H Office **every Tuesday** 4pm-5:30pm for six weeks. Workshops begin Tuesday October 3 and run through Tuesday, November 7. The district competition will be on Thursday afternoon, November 9 in Watkinsville. The 4-H van will transport students to the competition from school on Nov. 9, but parents will need to transport them to Tuesday workshops.
