

BLUEBERRIES:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)

Blueberries are relatively pest-free and require little care once established. The average family needs 4-6 bushes. Choosing varieties from the different seasons provides a broad harvest season.

Early Season: Climax; Premier
Mid Season: Powder Blue; Brightwell
Late Season: Tifblue; Delite



BLACKBERRIES/RASPBERRIES:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)

Blackberries and Raspberries are one of the most popular fruits to grow and they are among the easiest for the home gardener to successfully produce. Blackberries and raspberries come as erect types (no trellis required) and trailing types (trellis required) depending on the varieties selected.

Blackberries: Apache; Navaho
Raspberries: Dorman Red (trellis); Heritage



HUECHERA:

LIMITED AVAILABILITY

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)

Heucherella 'Golden Zebra' forms a mound of bright yellow leaves that are boldly marked with dark red veins. Sprays of small white bell flowers appear in spring. A great choice for adding drama to mixed containers and the front of the border.

Heuchera "Buttered Rum" Caramel-dipped, deeply-cut maple leaves adorn this aptly named plant from spring to summer. In fall, the leaves turn a lovely rose red.



FERNS:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)

Autumn Fern is a bold and beautiful choice for shady borders and woodland gardens. A dwarf-growing fern with young papery fronds that matures to a deep green.

Tassel Fern is a lustrous, shiny leaf fern which adds an elegant look to shaded gardens. Particularly beautiful when new fronds emerge stiffly, then droop backwards to form a tassel.

Japanese Painted Fern has dark, blue green central rib on fronds that fade to silver at the edges. Short habit and spreading form is excellent as foreground foliage and ideal for pots.



BUTTERFLY BUSH:

LIMITED AVAILABILITY

Cost \$10.00 (1 Gallon)

Butterfly Bush features bright fuchsia-pink (*Tutti Fruitti*) and vibrant blue (*Blue Heaven*) blooms from early summer to frost with a scented foliage. This plant is great for use in smaller areas of the garden. They will grow up to 2 to 3 feet tall and wide and attracts butterflies and hummingbirds.

Varieties: Tutti Fruitti; Blue Heaven



AZALEA:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)

'Hershey's Red' Azalea is a dwarf to semi-dwarf azalea bush (3 feet) with stunning rose red flowers and a dense, compact form. *'Hershey's Red'* looks wonderful planted in masses or used in borders.

'Mildred' Azalea is a low, dwarf to semi-dwarf mounding shrub (3 feet). A profuse bloomer with lavender pink flowers and a compact form. Evergreen leaves are deep green and make it a good choice for mass planting or as a low growing, informal hedge along a path or border.



GARDENIA:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)

'Frostproof' won the "2007 Garden Writers Best Plant Award". It typically grows 3-4 foot tall and prefers partial to full sun.



SPIRAEA BETULAFOLIA 'TOR'

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)

The neat mound of rich green foliage has tight clusters of brilliant white flowers. Foliage becomes gold, red, and purple in autumn. Grows up to 2-3' tall.



ABELIA GRANDFLORIA 'KALEIDOSCOPE'

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon) LIMITED AVAILABILITY

Bright, golden yellow variegation on medium green leaves along with brilliant red stems create a striking kaleidoscope of color. Reaches 2 to 2 1/2 ft. tall and 3 to 3 1/2 ft. wide.



ITEA VIRGINICA 'LITTLE HENRY'

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon) LIMITED AVAILABILITY

Compact shrub that attracts butterflies and has fragrant white flowers in the summer and shiny garnet-red foliage in the fall. Grows up to 2 to 3 ft. tall and wide.



DWARF LOROPETALUM 'PURPLE DAYDREAM'

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon) LIMITED AVAILABILITY

Petite shrub with dark purple foliage year-round and bursts of lovely pink string clusters each spring. Grows 2-3 feet tall by 3-4 feet wide.



HELLEBORUS 'BERRY SWIRL'

Cost \$12.00 (1 Gallon)

Upward facing, deep-red flowers cluster above the glossy, leathery deep green leaves. Grows up to 1 foot tall and 2 feet wide.



HYDRANGEA:

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)

'Little Lime' Dwarf shrub with attractive green summer flowers that turn pink in fall. Reaches 3 to 5 ft. tall and wide. This compact, hardy hydrangea fits easily into smaller landscapes, including container gardens.



CRAPE MYRTLE:

LIMITED AVAILABILITY

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)

'Midnight Magic' has superb purple-maroon foliage and offers loads of dark pink flowers. It has a rounded compact shape. It begins blooming in July when summer color is in short supply and remains colorful into September. Will grow up to 4 to 6 feet.

'Cherry Dazzle' has bronze new leaves, maturing to dark green, followed by masses of brilliant red flowers and showy red-purple foliage color in the fall. Drought tolerant when established. Will grow up to 3 to 5 feet.



VIBURNUM:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)

'Spring Bouquet' Viburnum is a versatile evergreen shrub that is truly easy to grow. Growing in sun to shade, Spring Bouquet is an excellent addition to the mixed shrub border or used as a low screen. Will grow up to 4 to 6 ft. tall and wide.

'Shasta' Viburnum has an elegant horizontal branching pattern. Prized for extra large clusters of white flowers that smother the bright green leaves. Plum-purple foliage and showy scarlet fruit in fall. An excellent hedge or specimen. Grows up to 6 ft. tall and 10 to 12 ft. wide.



CAMELLIA:

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)

'October Magic' Ivory Camellia has creamy white, fully double peony-like flower with ruffled petals will become your new favorite white-bloom camellia. Expect profuse blooms on a more manageable, vigorous, upright habit. Grows 6-8' tall x 5-7' wide.

'ShiShi Gashira' Camellia displays profuse, hot pink, semi-double blooms with golden yellow stamens in the center and glossy, dark evergreen foliage. Excellent choice for a colorful low hedge. Early to mid season bloomer. Reaches 6 ft tall by 8 ft wide.
