Tips for Creating Your Posters or Slides

- Create 1-4 posters or slides to introduce and illustrate your speech
- Posters or slides should be neat and simple don't use too many words or pictures!
- Words and pictures can be drawn by hand or printed and glued on to the poster
- Words and pictures should be large enough that you could read them from the other side of your classroom
- If using slides or printing off words for your poster, choose fonts that are simple and easy to read
- Include a introduction poster or slide that includes the title of your speech and your name. The rest of your posters or slides should include support for the three key ideas in your speech.
- Use key words or short statements instead of full sentences
- Your headings or titles should be larger than your points
- Your words and pictures should support the ideas in your speech
- You can use pictures, graphs, maps, charts, graphs, or diagrams as needed
- Practice using your posters or slides when you practice your speech. Practice switching between posters and slides as you talk.
