## Calling Wahsega

Parents should expect to:

- Have messages delivered to us on the same day that you call.
- Leave a voice mail if you are calling Wahsega after business hours.
- Relay emergency messages through the Lumpkin County 911 Center after hours at 706-864-3633

Parents should **not**:

- Call the 4-H Center to find out if the county has arrived safely. Instead, call the county office. Office hours are 8-12 & 1-5, Monday – Friday. Harris County Extension office 706-628-4824.
- Expect a call from a camper during the week. Please don't send cell phones to camp. Camp is in a remote location and most phones will not get service.

## OUR LOCATION

Wahsega 4-H Center is 12 miles north of Dahlonega on Forest Rd. 28 one mile from Camp Wahsega Rd. and the entrance to the Army Ranger Camp. We are in a valley shared by Ward Creek on property owned by UGA in the Chattahoochee National Forest in North Georgia Mountains.

## CAMPER MAIL received during camp

Campers may receive mail during the week of camp at Wahsega's address under the camper's name and county like this:

We encourage anyone who sends mail to campers to put letters in the mail the week before camp starts or earlier. **Please do not send food to campers.**

## E-MAIL to campers

You can send the camper e-mails throughout the week. Visit this web site **[www.georgia4h.org](http://www.georgia4h.org)**. Then click on "summer camp" in the left column. Then click "camper e-mail". Camper e-mail will not be located on this site until the week before camp. **You will need to know: Camp Wahsega, Cloverleaf Camp, June 3-7, password is "clover".** Please do not send any e-mails after Thursday afternoon. It is hard for the center to get and print them before we leave on Friday morning.

## Write encouraging letters

- If you choose to send a letter to your child while he or she is at camp, ask about camp activities, counselors, special programs and friends.
- Set a positive and encouraging tone in your letter.
- Express your confidence in the camper's maturity and ability to be away from home.
- Tell them that the adults and counselors are there to assist them if they should need anything.

## Drop Off and Pick Up Camper:

Monday, June 3

- Meet at the Harris County Agri-Center between 9:15-9:30 AM to load the busses for camp. Please label everything! Especially suitcases and sleeping bag (if taking one).
- Bring a sack lunch to picnic when we arrive at camp. A drink will be provided (bottle water). Please pack in a disposable sack with the camper's name on the bag. This needs to be kept with them on the bus.

Friday, June 7

- We will not stop for lunch. Plan to feed your camper after he/she returns.
- Pick up at the Harris County Agri-Center @ approximately 1:00-1:30 PM.
