Gallon Milk Jug Bird Feeder

Wash out gallon milk jug with soap and water. After dried paint the jug with the color of your choice. When the paint dries decorate the jug with your own creative design. Now that you have the jug painted and decorated you will need to collect some small sticks from your yard. Glue your sticks on the top of the jug to form a roof. After you complete your roof cut opening on the two sides opposite the jug handle. Make this large enough for the birds to get to the food.... about 2 inches from the bottom of the jug. Glue sticks along the bottom of the opening so the birds will have something to light on to eat their food. After you have completed your feeder tie a ribbon around the handle and tie in a tree near your house. Now you can sit back and watch your feathered friends enjoy the food you have provided for them.
