HORSE QUIZ BOWL—Thursdays...whether you have a horse or not, we want you to participate in the Horse Quiz Bowl! You just need a love of learning about horses. Weekly practices are on Thursdays from 3:30-5:30pm at the 4-H office. Ms. Shannon McBride is the coach; the State Contest is in January at Rock Eagle.

PEANUT RECIPE CONTEST—If you like to experiment in the kitchen, try creating your own peanut butter sandwich recipe. Add this to white bread with your choice of other edible items and ask another person to taste it. Write your recipe by listing ingredients and amounts to be used, the number of servings it makes and then the steps in making it. You can use the 4-H recipe card given out at your club meeting or another sheet of paper. Fill out the entry form and turn it in to your 4-H leaders at the **December club meeting**. Your recipes will be judged on nutrition, appeal, creativity, flavor, and technique/preparation.

ELITE NE TRIVIA TOURNAMENT— *November 20th...* at the Jackson County Ag Facility, 10am-4pm. This is a fun and laid-back competition where teams of 4-H'ers compete for the Trivia Championship Belt, currently held by Jackson County. 4-H'ers in grades 6th-12th are invited to take part. There will be lunch and an exhibit fair (very helpful for those working on their portfolios). Our service project is a diaper drive for the Diaper Bank of North Georgia, trivia participants will help sort diapers for delivery. The cost is \$6 per participant and adult. Teen Leader Opportunities for Fall Forum!

Hone in on Skills Teaching Your Own Workshop: You'll provide a topic (one that interests you) and materials needed to conduct a workshop.

Motivate Others by Teaching a Prepared Workshop: You'll teach a lesson developed by our Extension Specialists using materials supplied for you.

Lead a Service Activity: You'll lead a community service activity for participants during the Exhibit and Service Fair. Projects should be easy to do in a short amount of time and provide something for a group in need.

Recreation Leader: You'll be responsible for keeping participants actively engaged through leading recreation, ice breakers, game, etc. throughout the weekend.

Other Opportunities

Exhibitors: Fall Forum participants have the opportunity to showcase an exhibit focusing on his/her DPA project area. The exhibit can be on a tri-fold board. Awards will be given to the top exhibits! The first 100 participants to register to bring an exhibit will be selected.

4-H Cans Hunger: You're encouraged to collect canned goods and non-perishable items to donate to your local food bank. All you have to do is record the number of items you collected and turn that number in at Fall Forum.
