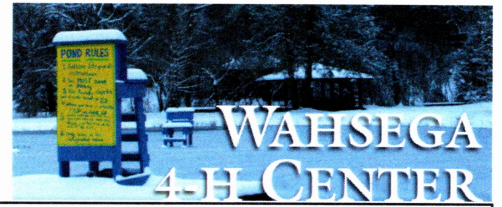


Activities include:
