



Is Your Food Safe After a Flood?

Floodwater can contaminate food with dangerous germs, silt, raw sewage, oil and chemicals, making it unsafe to eat.

KEEP

Food that has not contacted flood water

Food in waterproof containers that can be cleaned and sanitized

Undamaged canned food

THROW AWAY

Raw and cooked food that has contacted floodwater

Food in non-waterproof or cardboard containers

Home canned food (if submerged)

Canned food that is leaking, swollen or dented
