- 3—Watch for details about the date and time to register for the event that will be held in early February

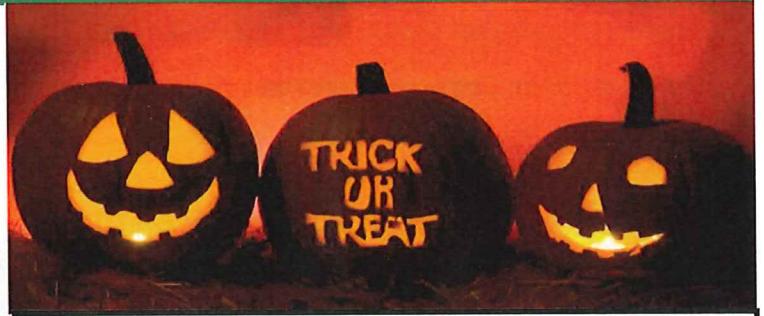

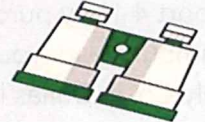
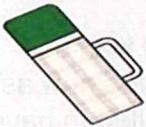

Georgia 4-H Peanut Recipe Contest

- The recipe should list ingredients yielding 1 sandwich, as well as directions for assembling the sandwich.
- Recipes can be written on Recipe entry form or on a separate piece of paper. Please turn in at your November Classroom Club meetings.
- Recipes will be judged on nutrition, appeal, creativity, recipe presentation, recipe content, and appropriateness for category.



Winners will be selected in a county contest as follows: One Overall Winner and winners in the 3 categories of Most Nutritious, Most Unusual and Most Creative.
