Place information in the appropriate cells as indicated in the copy of the form below.

If the cumulative score based on flock symptoms exceeds 10, submit the form by email to the Georgia Poultry Lab Network Hotline address. A "Submit Form" key is available on the form to facilitate submission. Alternatively, one can call the GPLN AI Hotline number indicated on the form.

It is suggested that you save a copy of the completed form before sending it to the GPLN AI Hotline.

A "Clear Form" Key is available on the fillable decision guide to empty the form and allow entry of new data.

2. Advise owner. Urge biosecurity. Inform owner that GA Dept. Agriculture or USDA representative may be in touch to get samples from birds.

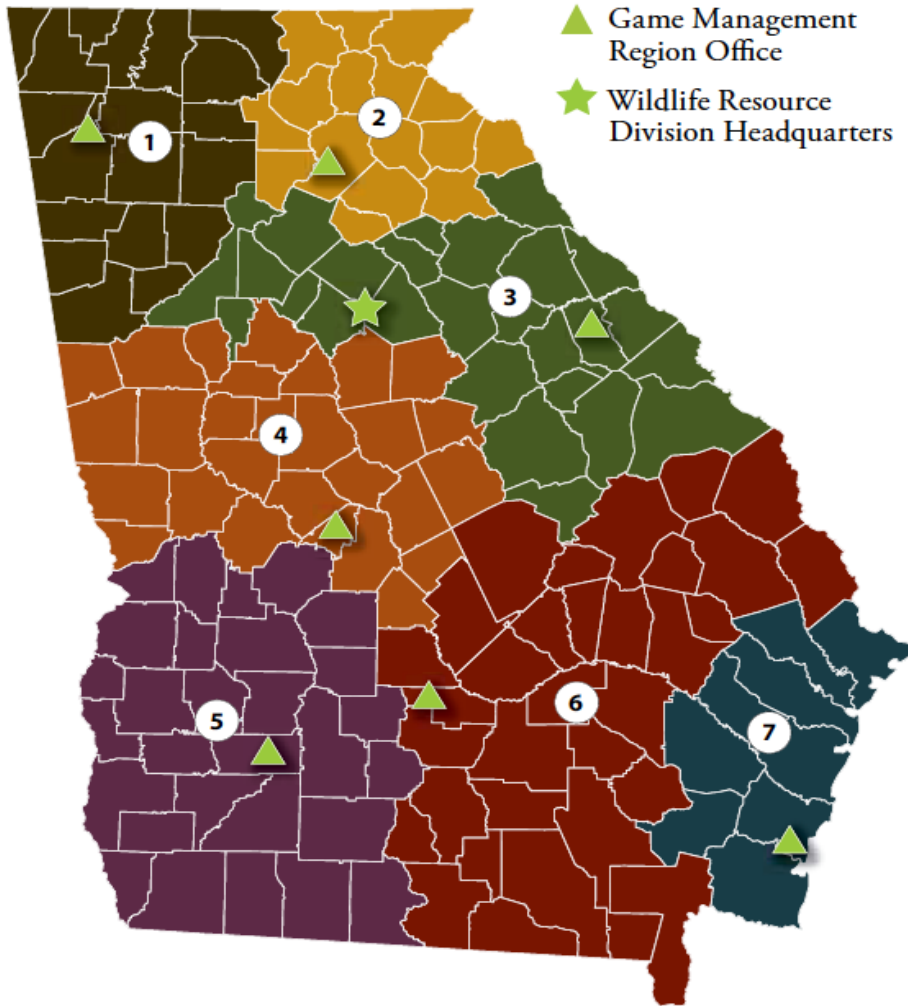
